General Description of Work:

Oversee the recovery program by providing leadership to reach program goals, implementing a culture of recovery, understanding the process of transformation, and enforcing program policies and procedures. This person should be committed to leading through a relational, Christian philosophy of grace and truth.

Responsibilities:

- Develop and implement the components of the recovery program; including curriculum, phases, schedule, etc.
- Provide weekly one-on-one coaching to all guests participating in the recovery program, including support and accountability in meeting goals and following shelter guidelines.
- Teach one or more weekly classes of the program.
- Document guest progress on database.
- Collaborate with other staff and volunteers regarding program guests and their case plan.
- Inform/advise the team regarding guest progress and recommendations (monthly).
- Support guests in leading the weekly Process Group.
- Work with the other team members to identify guests that would be good candidates for the Discovery Phase of the recovery program.
- Assist in the recruitment and training of teachers, instructors and mentors (in collaboration with Community Engagement Director and/or guests when appropriate).
- Oversee the planning of phase advancements and program graduations.
- Develop and upkeep program goals and outcomes.
- Assist in educating the public on homelessness and the challenges of children and mothers who are experiencing homelessness.
- Participate in the on-call rotation.

Qualifications:

- A keen manager of people—ability to hold accountable while maintaining relationship with staff and guests.
- Have strong interpersonal skills; including ability to diffuse conflict, maintain composure and treat all staff and guests with dignity and respect.
- The ability to create an environment that instills dignity and value in those who reside at the Christian Aid Center and promotes transformational growth.

• The ability to execute plans that reflect the overall strategic ends of the Christian Aid Center.

Education and Experience:

- College degree in related field (preferred)
- Two years of experience in similar field
- Substance Use Disorder training

Knowledge and Skills:

- Discernment in understanding a Christian model of personal change and a demonstrated ability to counsel others in the process of transformation.
- Good working knowledge of chemical dependency, addiction recovery, relapse prevention, and mental health.
- Ability to teach/facilitate groups and activities.
- Proficient in documentation, organization, scheduling.
